SCHOOL PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

AGES	TIME	DAYS	DESCRIPTION
<b>2's</b> 2 yr old by Oct. 1st	8:45 - 11:45	3 days M-W 2 days Th-F	A fun first experience in a school setting. They will build language and social skills with songs, movement, stories, playtime and art. In addition, large and fine motor skills will be a focus in their daily experiences at school. This is a fun and nurturing introduction to life outside of home.
<b>2.5's</b> 2 yr old by March 31st	8:45 - 11:45	3 days M-W 2 days Th-F	
<b>3's</b> 3 yr old by Oct. 1st	8:45 - 12:00	3 days M-W 4 days M-Th 5 days M-F	These classes have a focus on independence and social skills. Developmentally appropriate activities and experiences focus on emergent reading, writing, math, art, music and science instruction. We follow the Handwriting without Tears curriculum to support the learning of letters, numbers, shapes, and colors. A balance of educational and playful school experiences as their educational journey begins in the 3's class.
<b>4's</b> 4 yr old by Oct. 1st	8:45 - 12:00	4 days M-Th 5 days M-F	These classes focus on Kindergarten Readiness Skills while continuing to build social skills, problem solving, independence, and fine motor skills. The classes begin focusing on specific academics such as letters and sounds, beginning sight words, math and science concepts as well as opportunities for art and music. They follow the PreK Handwriting without Tears curriculum to support correct formation of letters and numbers.
<b>Almost 5's</b> Oct. - Dec. birthdate 5 yr old by January	8:45 - 1:00	M-F	The Almost 5's class follows the same curriculum as the 4's class, focusing on Kindergarten Readiness Skills. Though, there is an opportunity to target these children more specifically as they turn 5 early in the school year and are prepared developmentally for a faster pace of the curriculum and extension of the day that includes lunchtime. *Reading and STEAM Specialists support the students in this class during enrichment.

<b>Transitional Kindergarten</b> 5 yr old by Oct. 1 cutoff	8:45 - 2:30	M-F	A warm, nurturing environment with extensive personal attention to students. We provide a balanced program to prepare students for an academic Kindergarten. Teachers use the children's current stage of development to give them a year to grow socially and emotionally using Kindergarten standards as a guide to prepare them for the more academically focused Kindergarten program. The children's school day consists of purposeful activities with a developmental progression and allows for a variety of learning experiences. We strive to meet the developmental needs of each child and treat each as a valued individual. *Reading and STEAM Specialists support the students in this class.
<b>Kindergarten</b> 5 yr old by Oct. 1 cutoff	8:45 - 2:30	M-F	An academic program that prepares students for First Grade. Kindergarten at CPC provides a well-rounded foundation for students in a private school setting with small class sizes and personal attention to target students' learning goals, providing them with the skills and knowledge to excel in life beyond CPC. Our Kindergarten Program allows for a variety of learning experiences, including cooking, field trips, performing arts, leadership opportunities and community service projects. Our students grow into well-rounded individuals with a love of learning! *Reading and STEAM Specialists support the students in this class.
<b>Enrichments</b> 3's, 4's, Almost 5's	12-2:30, 1-2:30	M-Th	Classes designed to enhance the curriculum and explore STEAM topics. Choose the days that you would like to extend the day until 2:30. Includes lunch for 3's & 4's.
<b>Early Drop-off</b> 3+	Arrival beginning at 8:00	M-F	An early drop off opportunity for children ages 3+ beginning at 8am. Sign up as needed.
<b>Lunch Bunch</b>	1pm Dismissal	Varies	An opportunity to extend the day with lunch and play. Sign up as needed.
